RULES & REGULATIONS

1. Persons reserving a space are fully responsible for setting it up, monitoring at all times, dispensing change, and cleaning up at the end of the flea market.
2. Food and non-alcoholic beverages for personal consumption are permitted. Sale of food and beverages for profit during the day by persons with space reservations is strictly prohibited.
3. Alcoholic beverages are strictly prohibited.
4. Loud music is strictly prohibited.
5. Persons reserving space are strictly prohibited from bringing pets to the flea market.
6. Parking is limited to the street only. NO vehicles will be allowed on park grounds.
7. Persons are asked to set up (tables, displays, merchandise) between 7:00 a.m. and 8:00 a.m. Kick-off is 8:00 a.m. Break down should be completed between noon and 1:00 p.m.
8. Numbered spaces will be assigned to sellers the morning of the flea market - go to the check-in point at the baseball diamond.
9. Each space is 8 feet by 10 feet.

DISCLAIMER OF RESPONSIBILITY

1. The Wyman Park Community Association, Inc. ("WPCA") is not responsible for any theft of items displayed or for damage to any property brought to the flea market by individuals with space reservations.
2. The WPCA is not responsible for theft of monies collected or retained at the individual space.
3. The WPCA is not responsible for providing change, tables, or display equipment.
4. The WPCA flea market is scheduled for September 20, 2008 with a rain date of October 4. If the flea market cannot be held on those two dates due to inclement weather, 75% of the space reservation fee will be refunded upon request.
5. The WPCA reserves the right to cancel any space reservation request if the reservation request exceeds the allowable space for the flea market (8 feet by 10 feet) pursuant to the permit obtained from the City of Baltimore.
